Cultural Program

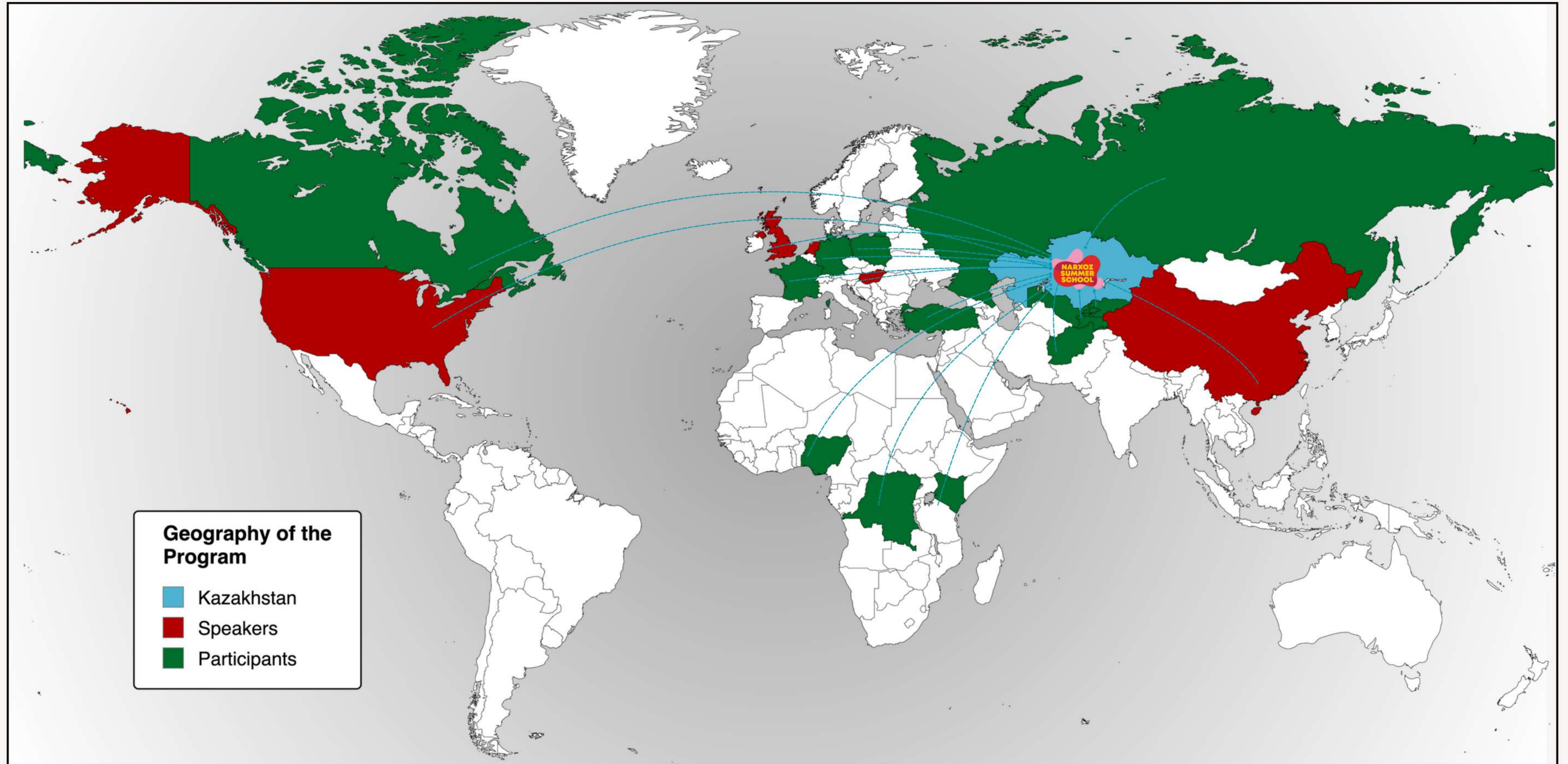
