The summer (April-May) requires lighter clothes. The annual temperature of Bangalore is between 14-degree Celsius and 37 Degree Celsius.

**Local Travel:**

Bangalore has a wide spread city bus network. Cabs and Auto rickshaws are available on hire. NSB has its own transport to campus from designated places in city and other living spaces and is provided on complimentary basis.

**Textbooks & Course material:**

Wherever necessary, the school will make arrangements for providing prescribed textbook and course material *on actual cost basis*. However, the students have to independently purchase stationery items required by them. Printing & Photocopying facility is available at the school. The students will be charged on actual usage basis.
