

1. About Universiti Putra Malaysia

Universiti Putra Malaysia (UPM) in Kuala Lumpur is ranked as the second best university in Malaysia (Times Higher Education 2016) and acknowledged among the top 400 universities in the world (QS World Ranking, place 143rd). UPM is a public university, established in 1931. It has 15 faculties, 2 schools and 11 institutes. Approximately 24 000 students. The university is located just outside the capital of Kuala Lumpur and is among the elite institutions in the city.

Was first established as the School of Agriculture in 1931. The school was located on a 22-acre piece of land in Serdang and offered two programmes - a three-year diploma programme and a one-year certificate course in Agriculture. In 1947, the school was declared the College of Agriculture Malaya by Sir Edward Gent, the then Governor of the Malayan Union.

UPM is a multidisciplinary university that has 83years of history, and located strategically within the Multimedia Super Corridor, which is only 10 minutes' drive to Putrajaya and 30 minutes' drive to the Kuala Lumpur City Centre. As one of the largest universities in Malaysia, UPM is also a keyplayer in contributing to the growth of learned and skilled human capital in the nation. UPM presently has more than 30,000 students enrolled in its 80 bachelor, 8 diploma and 66 postgraduate programmes at the Masters and PhD levels (with more than 300 fields of studies). Except for the programmes which diploma are offered exclusively at UPM's branch campus in Bintulu. Sarawak all other courses are offered at the main campus in Serdang, Selangor.

3. UPM Inbound Mobility Programme



Universiti Putra Malaysia's study abroad and exchange programme is designed to encourage students from universities abroad to do short-term academic-related stints at UPM.

The exchange programs in UPM began in late 1990's with only a few students participated in the program mainly to conduct their practical training and research in the field of science and technology such as Veterinary Medicine. Now, UPM has more than 199 Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) to foster student exchange programmes with universities from all over the world, and each year, hundreds of international students come to UPM from different parts of the world.

- Download Inbound Application form and prepare supporting documents
- Application deadline for semester exchange is every 30th October for March intake and 30th May for October intake.

2. Submit

•Submit application form and supporting documents at least 4 month before programme begin to mobility@upm.edu.my Note: Application processing at UPM will take approximately 30 days)

3. Apply e-VAL (Visa Approval Letter)

• After receive offer letter, student to proceed applying e-VAL through EMGS website if mobility programme is 3 months and above: https://educationmalaysia.gov.my/

4. Attain SEV (Single Entry Visa)

• After receiving e-VAL student required to attained SEV at Malaysian Embassy in home country or through window Malaysia (China student)

5. Travel

Arrived in Malaysia and begin registration at UPM

Inbound Application Requirement and Supporting Documents

- 1. Student should have completed 2 semesters at home university
- 2. Student have English language competence (TOEFL/ELTS or university confirmation)
- 3. Applicants must download the application (**OPR/INTL/BR01/INBOUND**) form through <u>www.intl.upm.edu.my</u> and submit it to <u>mobility@upm.edu.my</u>; following form, we also require additional relevant documents, which include:
 - Acknowledgment of nomination from the home university or recommendation letter from the home university through their international office.
 - ➤ Certified copies of academic transcripts (subjects/courses that have been completed).
 - Non-English speaking country please provide English language certificate or letter from lecturer about your level of English knowledge.
- Republic of China students, are require to submit a 2-minutes video interview (compressed mpeg4 format, size must not more than 5mb) and to explain (in English) about themselves and why they wanted to study in UPM and online interview may be conducted based on faculty requirements.

- After receive the offer letter and welcoming pack, student may start to register, fees payment to UPM Account Number, contact Academic advisor as per stated in the offer letter.

Inbound Application Requirement and Supporting Documents

- 1. Student should have completed 2 semesters at home university
- 2. Student have English language competence (TOEFL/ELTS/CIEP or university confirmation)
- 3. Applicants must download the application (**OPR/INTL/BR01/INBOUND**) form through <u>www.intl.upm.edu.my</u> and submit it to <u>mobility@upm.edu.my</u>; following form, we also require additional relevant documents, which include:
 - Acknowledgment of nomination from the home university or recommendation letter from the home university through their international office.
 - ➤ Certified copies of academic transcripts (subjects/courses that have been completed).
 - Non-English speaking country please provide English language certificate or letter from lecturer about your level of English knowledge.
- Republic of China students, are require to submit a 2-minutes video interview (compressed mpeg4 format, size must not more than 5mb) and to explain (in English) about themselves and why they wanted to study in UPM and online interview may be conducted based on faculty requirements.

6. After Receiving UPM Offer Letter

Every International students whom applying for inbound in UPM are required to enter Malaysia with correct documentations. For international students who wish to study more than 3 months to UPM; student are required to apply e-VAL (https://educationmalaysia.gov.my/). For student whom studying less than 3 months in UPM, they are required to attain professional pass (please contact our mobility officer and learn how).

7. Student Pass and Visa Requirement

Student pass application is need to be by **student** through Education made Malaysia Global Services Malaysia (EMGS) website before coming to Malaysia. You are required to make VAL payment to EMGS during the application payment section, there will be 2 option (which is to pay using credit card and Pay to Institutions), please choose pay through credit card. If you do not have credit card vou may made payment through telegraphic transfer (at any banks nearby you at home country) as per below details:



8. Health Insurance

It is compulsory for every student entering Malaysia to have medical insurance. You need to be insured from the date you enter. All international students must be covered by a locally purchased medical health insurance scheme.

Students are reminded that it is compulsory for them to have a valid medical insurance plan throughout the period of study. International students whose medical and health insurance cover period expires prior to the expiry of their existing student pass are required to top up/extend their insurance. This top up/extension should be sufficient to cover the period up to the expiry of their existing student pass or a maximum of 12 months from the insurance start date, whichever is lower.






