# International Student Mobility Programs at GSB

## GSB Partnership Agreements

- **Organized by the International Office:** competitive selection, nomination, document preparation, and—if needed—communication with the host university
- Tuition at the host university **is free**
- Eligible students can apply for a **GSB scholarship**

## Freemovers

- Students independently find a university, contact it, submit documents, and send the Acceptance Letter to the International Office
- Tuition at the host university is covered by the student
- More detailed information is available [on the website](#) in the "Freemovers" section

## University-wide Competition (HSE agreements)

- Takes place in 3 waves
- Detailed information and application forms are [on the website](#)

## Short-term programs

- Duration: 7-10 days
- Options: via GSB competition or independent application to Summer/Winter Schools



# Requirements for Participants

- ✓ No academic debts
- ✓ High academic performance
- ✓ English proficiency at B2 level or higher
- ✓ Students on academic leave are not eligible to participate

## Undergraduate

- Completion of at least 1 academic year at HSE GSB

## Graduate

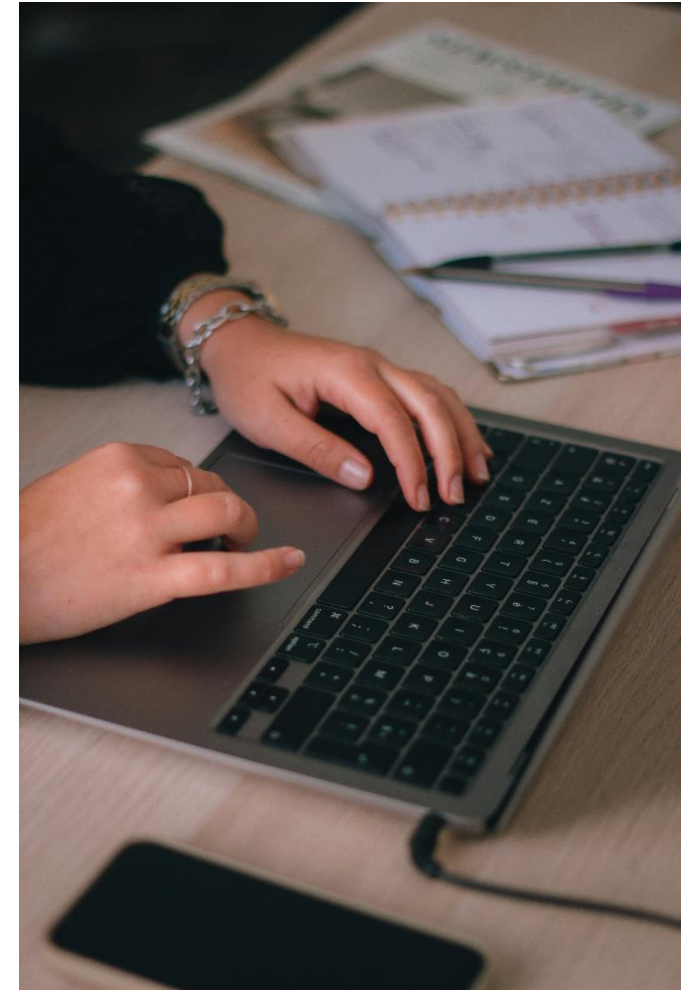
- Completion of at least 1 academic year by the time of departure
- Participation must be approved by the academic supervisor
- Ability to complete internship, pass HSE disciplines, and include electives in the Individual Study Plan
- Consent to reschedule thesis defense (if necessary)

- **Main intake:**  
**August 1 – September 20, 2025** 
- **University-wide Competition**

**August 25 – November 9, 2025 (3 waves)**

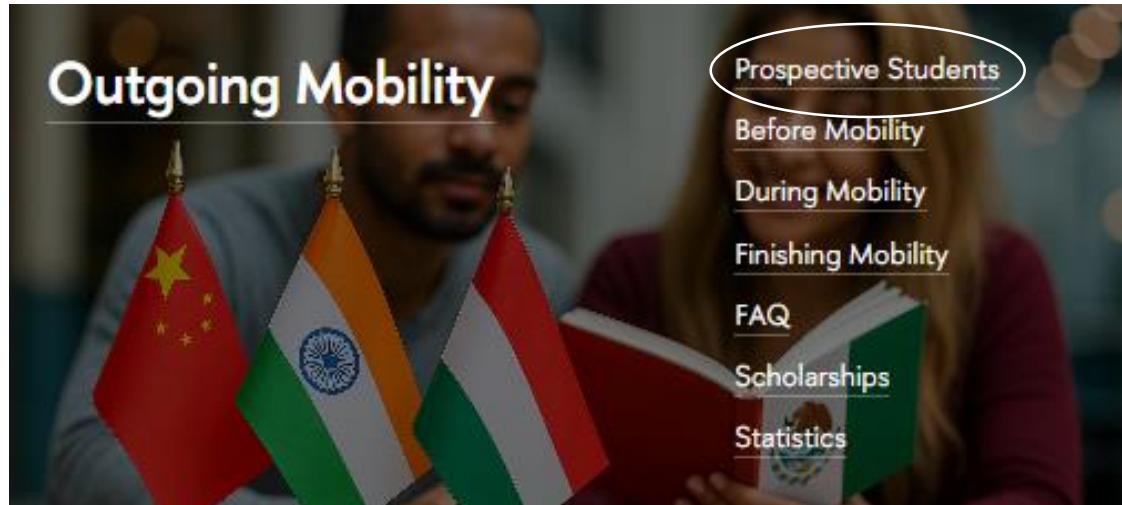

# Application Submission

## 1. Decide on the Program

- You can choose **up to 3 priority universities**, based on your budget and the courses offered
- Review the **statistics** of past selections and check the minimum passing scores

## 2. Plan Your Budget

- Tuition is free, BUT all other expenses are covered by the student (visa, insurance, tickets, accommodation, service fees etc.)
- Study the Factsheet of the partner university and visit **Numbeo** website (living expenses)
- Include unforeseen expenses for each month

\*If you are studying on a commercial (tuition-paying) basis, you continue to pay tuition fees to GSB.



# Application Submission

## 3. Prepare your document package

- For each university, an individual document package must be prepared in **.pdf** format
- If you have **3** priorities, then you must prepare **3** of documents, but you only fill out the application **once**

## 4. Submit your application

- All documents must be uploaded in .pdf format
- The application for the university-wide competition is submitted separately



# Results

- Within **3–4 weeks** after the application deadline, you'll receive an email with the results at your @edu.hse.ru address
- You'll have **1–2 days** to confirm your willingness to participate
- Then the Application Period to partner universities starts. A webinar will be held with instructions for nominated students

# Document Package

## 1. Application for the Competition

- Must be signed by the student, program manager, and academic director of the degree program
- Submit to the Study Office no later than 10 days before the deadline
- Must include confirmation of no academic debts

## 2. Proof of Foreign Language Proficiency

- Official language certificate
- Result of the Independent English Exam by HSE
- Result of the Internal English Exam by HSE (extract from the online grade book)
- Certificate for master's students studying in English
- Result of the CCT ["Linguotest"](#)





# Document Package

## 3. Motivation Letter

- Ideally, write a separate letter for each university (3 priorities = 3 letters)
- Length: approximately 500 words
- We recommend watching the [workshop](#) on writing a motivation letter
- Should be written in English

## 4. Recommendation Letter

- Preferably one for each university, but a universal letter is also acceptable
- Author: a professor of a core discipline at HSE, academic supervisor, or program director
- Important: Letters from English language teachers are not accepted
- Should be written in English
- There are no strict formatting requirements, but it's helpful to review commonly used formats

## 5. Resume/CV

- Must be prepared in English
- You may use your own format

## 6. Budget Estimate

- Should be calculated based on:
  - The partner university's factsheet
  - [Numbeo](#) website
- A budget template is available on the [website](#)

## Algorithm for preparing a Preliminary Study Plan

### Step 1.

Open your programme curriculum (see links to course curricula at the bottom of this page)

### Step 2.

Select the year of enrolment at HSE University and open the course curriculum for the time period when you plan to be on exchange.

Demonstrate high academic performance (current and cumulative GPA  $\geq 7.5$ )

Have academic achievements and/or actively participate in faculty life
