

#### **ISBU PROGRAM COSTS**



<sup>\*</sup>Generally speaking, there is no tuition for students enrolled at and nominated by ULaval partner universities.

Students who wish to take both ISBUs receive a Can\$150 discount on the second enrolment. A group discount of Can\$150 per enrolment also applies to more than 10 enrolments from a single institution.

#### The basic fee includes the following services and activities:

- Université Laval residence accommodation: standard single-occupancy room located just steps away from FSA ULaval. Bedding is included. Kitchens and bathrooms are shared with other residents
- Weekday lunches (10 days)
- Unlimited city bus pass
- Guided tour of Old Québec
- Evening gathering and graduation ceremony
- On-campus Wi-Fi
- Academic lectures, corporate visits and conferences by industry leaders
- A host of social and cultural activities in which to experience the Québec City lifestyle
- Festival d'été de Québec pass (only for students enrolled in the Modern Real-Life Operations Management and Logistics ISBU)






#### **UNDERGRADUATE COURSES**

- corporate visits in dynamic Québec-based companies active internationally and in key industries of our economy.


