Courseload	 Please follow the specific requirements set by your home university during the exchange period. On average exchange students take 4, 20 gradits per semester. 						
Course Degistration	 On average, exchange students take 4 -20 credits per semester. The course selection/registration system will officially open on the first day 						
Course Registration	of the new semester.						
	 Undergraduate: The course registration period usually lasts one week; There are two stages during this time: (1) Adding/Dropping; (2) Adding ONLY 						
	- Students are able to withdraw ONE course (if needed) around						
	mid-semester (shown as "W" on transcript).						
	- Graduate:						
	 The course registration period usually lasts one to two weeks; 						
	 Students are able to add or drop courses during this time; 						
	- There is NO "withdrawal" option available after the course						
	 registration period; For English courses, students are free to choose offerings from ACEM's MIB program (Master of International Business). *Please note that the MBA program is run by a different office (MBA Center) with separate nominations and procedures. MBA courses are exclusively offered for their students and are NOT open to regular graduate exchange students. During the designated course selection/registration period, students are free to go to classes they are interested in taking before officially registering. 						
	• There is no limitation to choosing courses offered on different campuses.						
	Exchange students are free to choose what best fits their study plans.						
	Once the course registration period passes, students CANNOT make any more						
	changes to their course schedule. Please pay special attention to the specific
