#### Bangalore Palace

The palace was built in the year 1887 by King Chamaraja Wadiyar and is today open to the public who come to witness the lavish and elegant splendour of one of South India's most enduring dynasties.



The palace features mainly wooden interiors and is surrounded by gardens. The architectural style is a mix of Tudor and Scottish Gothic with many physical elements inside imported from Britain. It is believed that Chamaraja Wadiyar found inspiration in Windsor Castle and other structures of Normandy and England.

#### Lalbagh

Lalbagh Botanical Gardens or Lalbagh is an old botanical garden in Bengaluru, India. It hosts two flower shows coinciding with the week of Republic Day (26 January) and Independence Day (15



August). As an urban green space, it is also home to numerous wild species of birds and other wildlife. The garden also has a lake adjoining a large rock on which a watchtower had been constructed during the reign of Kempegowda II.

#### City Market

K. R. Market (Krishna Rajendra Market), also known as City Market, is the largest wholesale market dealing with commodities in Bangalore, India. It is named after Krishnarajendra Wodeyar,



a former ruler of the princely state of Mysore. The market is located in the Kalasipalyam area, adjacent to the Tipu Sultan's Summer Palace. It is the first locality in the whole of Asia to get electricity and considered to be one of the biggest flower markets in Asia.
